GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a skilled position in the construction, operation and maintenance areas of the electric distribution section who works under the general direction of Foreman in Electric Distribution Operations.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS:

- Reports directly to one of the Foreman Electric Distribution Operations.
- Work is performed under the general direction of an Electric Operations Superintendent subject to departmental policy as established by the Manager Electric Operations, all applicable Government legislation pertaining to electrical distribution installations and applicable safety procedures and the Electric Utility Bylaw and Safe Work Procedures.
- Develops and maintains strong working relationships with City Operations and City staff.
- External relationships are established and maintained with consultants, contractors, suppliers, and members of the general public.

PRIMARY FUNCTIONS/ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Installs, maintains and repairs all components of the street lighting and electrical distribution systems.
- Performs work on energized or de-energized circuits depending on system requirements.
- Performs switching operations as directed by Electric Distribution supervisory or managerial staff when required for circuit switching and load transfers.
- Provides leadership and guidance to groundman operators, utility helpers, casual labourers and apprentices in his crew during normal working day-to-day operations.
- Provides training and mentorship guidance to Apprentices assigned to the crew.
- Assumes the duties and responsibilities of the Foreman Operations in the absence of the regular Foreman Operations.
- Ensures that all equipment, tools and vehicles allocated to this crew are fully equipped, inspected, cleaned and maintained.
- Performs emergency and/or planned stand-by duties as required according to the approved departmental stand-by rotation.
- Requisitions materials as required from the Electric Stores daily.
- In cooperation and with the approval of the Foreman Operations, schedules work on a day-today basis such that projects are completed efficiently and safely.
- Ensures that materials, labour and equipment costs are charged to the correct work order (account) number.
- Returns unused materials to the Electric Stores.

- Notifies the Foreman Operations of changes or modifications to the distribution system or departures from design drawings.
- Studies and marks up standard drawings and design packages on each job to include with asbuilt package to work management and design.
- Works collaboratively in a team-based work setting to achieve goals and complete workload.
- Performs related or unrelated duties as required in the event of insufficient work as a Journeyman Power Line Technician.

REQUIRED COMPETENCIES:

- Thorough knowledge of the standard methods, materials, tools and equipment of the Power Line Technician's trade.
- Thorough knowledge of the principles and safe work methods used when working on all low, medium, and high voltage Electric Utility distribution and transmission systems.
- Thorough knowledge of the Provincial Electrical Utility Regulations, Occupational Health and Safety Regulations and the City of Medicine Hat Accident Prevention, and Environment Health and Safety Policies.
- Review, understand, commit and work in the safest possible manner consistent with Occupational Health and Safety Legislation and the City's Health, Safety and Environment Management System.
- Proficient in the use of Microsoft and other current office software in a network environment and ability to become competent with the City specific software programs.
- Ability to understand and execute oral and written instructions and to interpret work orders, procedures and design drawings.
- Act as a safety champion, follows all rules, guidelines and SOP's and puts personal and public safety at the forefront of each job.
- Able to communicate ideas, job steps, hazards and barriers to team, contractors, and the public.
- Able to communicate effectively and clearly in day to day tasks and emergency situations.
- Ability to locate, diagnose and repair faults and defects on the distribution and transmission systems.
- Ability to climb poles and work from ladders and man-lift equipment of various heights.
- Ability to work in confined spaces and trenches in all conditions.
- Ability to work outdoors under extreme weather conditions for extended periods of time.
- Knowledge of the City of Medicine Hat Electric Distribution System.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possession of a valid Journeyman Power Line Technician Red Seal Trade Certificate.
- Five (5) years of experience as a Journeyman in the construction, operation and maintenance of an Electric Distribution System.
- Possess and maintain a current Class 3 Alberta motor vehicle operator's license with an acceptable driving record.
- An equivalent combination of management approved education and experience may be considered.
